Supporting VHF-Channels

VHF Ch. 11: Harbour Coordination Centre (Traffic issues)

- Who: All moored seagoing vessels
- When: Pilot requests, tugboats and/or linesmen;
 - The planned voyage can not be undertaken;
 - If incidents occur;
 - Emergency services are required;
 - Commencing/terminating special works for which permission has been granted.

VHF Ch. 14: Harbour Coordination Centre (Operational issues)

Who: All moored seagoing vessels

- When: If permission is required to execute special works such as;
 - Lowering lifeboats;
 - Diving activities;
 - Lightering activities with floating cranes;
 - Bunkering etc.

VHF Ch. 19: Harbour Coordination Centre

- What: Weather reports every H + 50 when expected wind force >8Bft.
- Note: It is recommended to listen out on this channel when moored.
